

# Inauguration-Related Schedule for Homeless Services in the **DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA**




# STREET CLOSURES AND RESTRICTED AREAS:

Areas around the Capitol and White House will be closed off for inauguration-related activities. Road closures will begin on Wednesday, January 18.

## ASSISTANCE MOVING OUT OF THE PERIMETER:

Areas inside the perimeter will be subject to restricted entry before and on the day of the inauguration. If you are staying inside the perimeter, you will likely be displaced. Please reach out to your Case Manager or to the Shelter Hotline at 202.399.7093 or 311 to request assistance with transportation and temporary storage of your belongings. Please make these arrangements as soon as possible.
