
Organizing and funding of many non-ceremonial inaugural events



TYPES OF ALERTS

Nixle

Signup via text

Opt-in texting alerts for a specific event. Used previously for July 4, NATO Summit, and others with many visitors.

WEA

Automatic alerts

Wireless Emergency Alerts (WEA) are sent to all phones within a defined geographic area for specific hazards.
